2020 LSB 3D Archery League Info & Rules

NEW this year a range finder division has been added. The league will begin on Tuesday, May 19th and run for twelve weeks ending on Thursday, August 13th. There is a bye week for June 30-July 2nd. The teams will consist of two shooters. If you don't have two people for a team you can sign up and we will help form a team. The course is sprayed for bugs.

Shooting hours will be from 4:00 p.m. until dark on Tuesday and Wednesday nights. Thursday nights will be the rain date night if weather prohibits you from shooting on Tuesday or Wednesday.

Clubhouse will be open Tuesday and Wednesday nights. Stop in for a pizza, beer, soda or enjoy some FREE popcorn in the air conditioning.

Teams will be placed into divisions based on their team's average score after the third week of league. The number of divisions will be based on the quantity of teams that are signed up and the number of teams participating or not participating in the range finder class. *If only one of your team members is using a range finder your entire team will still be placed in the range finder division.

Top shooters in each division to receive payout. Payout structure will be based on quantity of shooters in league.

2020 3D League Rules

- 1) Working Club Members can shoot any day of the week, privilege of being a Working member
- 2) If gate leading to 3D course is closed, and you're not a working member with full access to the course do not attempt to shoot.
- 3) All cards to be turned in weekly by Sunday
- 4) Card requirements
 - a. Shooters Name
 - b. Team Name
 - c. Designate Week shooting, example WK 8, WK 9, etc. (dates gets confusing if you're missing a week on score sheet).
- 5) At the conclusion of the third week of league all previous weeks not recorded will be given the score of 90% of average.
- 6) There will be a one-week grace period for getting scores in. For example, it is now week 6 and you have not shot for week 4 or 5. Week 4 will now be given your average minus 10 %.
- 7) No more using one score for extended weeks ahead or for previous missed weeks. Take advantage of homing in your skills by making use of the course to your benefit.
- 8) You can make up weeks by shooting two arrows per target to catch up. First arrow must be used on the same scorecard throughout the course, along with the second arrow being scored only on second card. It is not necessary to go through the course twice.
- 9) If you know you're going to be missing some weeks, call or contact 3D board head so you can make other arrangements and not take the point reduction.
- 10) Designated week 12 is the end of the season, all scores not in by Sunday of that week will now take the reduction in points for any missing week.
